Introducing yourself	Let me introduce myself. My name is ... I'm a ... / I'm the ...	I work for ... I've been ... for ... years. I'm responsible for ...

Main part

Linking and sequencing	So now that we've looked at ..., I'd like to turn to ... Let's move on to ... This brings me to my final point. I'd like to hand (you) over to ...
Referring to visuals	As you can see on this slide, ... If you look at the graph, you'll see that ... What this table shows is that ...

Ending

Summarising	So, to sum up, ... We looked at ... followed by ... And then I explained the importance of ...

Dealing with questions	Sorry, I didn't catch your question. That's a good question. / That's an interesting question. Thank you for raising that point. I'm afraid I don't know the answer to that one, but ...
