Reasons for using a dictionary

- **Comprehension (decoding):**
 - To look up unknown words met whilst listening, reading or translating
 - To confirm the meanings of partly known words
 - To confirm guesses from context
- **Production (encoding):**
 - To look up unknown words needed to speak, write or translate
 - To look up the spelling, pronunciation, inflections and derived forms of partly known words needed to speak, write or translate
 - To confirm the spelling, pronunciation, meaning, etc. of known words
 - To check that a word exists
 - To find a different word to use instead of a known one
 - To correct an error
- **Learning:**
 - To choose unknown words to learn
 - To enrich knowledge of partly known words, including etymology

Skills needed to use a dictionary

- **Receptive use:**
 - Get information from the context where the word occurred
 - Find the dictionary entry
 - Choose the right sub-entry
 - Relate the meaning to the context and decide if it fits
- **Productive use:**
 - Find the wanted word form
 - Check that there are no unwanted constraints on the use of the word
 - Work out the grammar and collocations of the word
 - Check the spelling/pronunciation of the word before using it

What to consider when choosing a dictionary

- **For comprehension:**
 - The dictionary should contain lots of words and word groups.
 - The meanings should be easy to understand.
 - Derived words and word groups should be easy to find.
 - The meanings should be easy to find.
 - There should be examples and collocations to guide the search and confirm that the appropriate meaning has been found.
- **For production:**
 - There should be ways of finding the appropriate word.
 - The dictionary should provide information about constraints on use of the word.
 - The dictionary should provide plenty of understandable example sentences as models for use.
 - The dictionary should contain easily understood information about the grammar and collocations of the word.
 - The dictionary should show the spelling of inflected and derived forms.
 - The dictionary should show how the word is pronounced.
