# "Corpus-based vocabulary research and the use of dictionaries"

## Reasons for using a dictionary

### Comprehension (decoding):

- o To look up unknown words met whilst listening, reading or translating
- To confirm the meanings of partly known words
- o To confirm guesses from context

## Production (encoding):

- o To look up unknown words needed to speak, write or translate
- To look up the spelling, pronunciation, inflections and derived forms of partly known words needed to speak, write or translate
- o To confirm the spelling, pronunciation, meaning, etc. of known words
- To check that a word exists
- o To find a different word to use instead of a known one
- o To correct an error

## • Learning:

- o To choose unknown words to learn
- o To enrich knowledge of partly known words, including etymology

## Skills needed to use a dictionary

#### Receptive use:

- o Get information from the context where the word occurred
- Find the dictionary entry
- Choose the right sub-entry
- o Relate the meaning to the context and decide if it fits

## • Productive use:

- o Find the wanted word form
- o Check that there are no unwanted constraints on the use of the word
- Work out the grammar and collocations of the word
- o Check the spelling/pronunciation of the word before using it

## What to consider when choosing a dictionary

### • For comprehension:

- The dictionary should contain lots of words and word groups.
- The meanings should be easy to understand.
- o Derived words and word groups should be easy to find.
- The meanings should be easy to find.
- There should be examples and collocations to guide the search and confirm that the appropriate meaning has been found.

### • For production:

- There should be ways of finding the appropriate word.
- o The dictionary should provide information about constraints on use of the word.
- o The dictionary should provide plenty of understandable example sentences as models for
- The dictionary should contain easily understood information about the grammar and collocations of the word.
- o The dictionary should show the spelling of inflected and derived forms.
- The dictionary should show how the word is pronounced.
